## **CURB SIDE PICKUP ITEMS**

**#1 PETE PLASTIC:** Including soda, liquor & water bottles

**#2 HDPE CLEAR PLASTIC JUGS:**  
Including milk, cider, window washer fluid jugs & some soap jugs

**#2 HDPE SOLID COLORED PLASTIC:** Including detergent, shampoo, and maple jugs

**GLASS:** Including all glass bottles clear or colored and window glass

**ALUMINUM CANS:** Including all soda & beer cans (**NO** cat or dog food cans)

**TIN CANS:** Including soup, tuna fish, cat or dog food, etc.

**MAGAZINE & NEWSPAPERS:**  
Including all inserts, soft covered books, glossy paper & catalogs

**CORRUGATED CARDBOARD:**  
Including all double-walled boxes (Boxes **must** be broken down & flattened)

**LOW GRADE PAPER:** Including junk mail, cereal boxes, etc. (Boxes **must** be broken down & flattened)

**NOTE:** ALL CAPS & FOOD MUST BE REMOVED. PLACE ITEMS IN SEPARATE CONTAINERS ACCORDING TO TYPE. ALL CURB SIDE ITEMS MUST BE OUT BY 7a.m. ALL TRASH MUST BE IN TOWN BAGS & TIED. THE MAXIMUM WEIGHT IS 30 POUNDS.



## **DROP-OFF ITEMS**

**APPLIANCES:** There will be a \$10 Fee for REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, & AIR CONDITIONERS

**CLEAN ASPHALT SHINGLES:**  
Including tar paper & double coverage roofing (a \$36 per yard fee will be charged for these items)

**BATTERIES:** Including car, truck, equipment & any rechargeable

**TEXTILES:** Including pants, shirts, coats, socks, sleepwear, sheets, blankets & shoes

**WASTE MOTOR OIL:** All motor oil & filters (We burn waste oil for heat)

**COMPOST PILE LEAVES & YARD WASTE:** NO brush or pet manure (Compost and wood chips are free to take for Town Residents)

**SCRAP METAL:** NO plastic, rubber, or wood

**TIRES:** All tires **NEED** to be approved before they are unloaded at the transfer station. (There will be a charge of \$1.50 per car tire for commercial enterprises; and large truck & tractor tires will be charged by size from \$30 to \$800)

**PAINT:** All latex will be accepted from May 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup>

**DEMOLITION & CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS:** Including plywood, painted wood, plastic toys, rugs, sheetrock & fiberglass. (Will be accepted for a fee of \$20 per cubic yard with a \$2 minimum)

**OLD FURNITURE:** Including tv's, vacuum cleaners, computers, etc. (Will be accepted for a fee per piece)

**BRUSH & UNPAINTED WOOD:** less than 5" in diameter – may go in the burn pile. Any one putting painted wood or other unacceptable items in the burn pile will be charged a demolition fee

**FLUORESCENT BULBS:** There is a \$.10 per foot charge
